We greet you with the peace and love of our Lord Jesus Christ!

We are pleased to inform you that the members of our community, Bukas Loob Sa Diyos Covenant Community, have responded to the call of our Global Community Spiritual Director Archbishop Angel N. Lagdameo, to come to the aid of the victims of typhoons "Ondoy", "Pepeng" and "Santi." Our community members from different parts of the globe have generously responded and sent in their cash donations which we have allocated to the various typhoon-affected areas.

It is with joy and gratitude to let you know that we received a total of **Two Million Five Hundred Seventy Five Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty Eight Pesos and Eighty Three Centavos (Php 2,575,788.83) in cash.** Please refer to Annex A for list of donors by District and the corresponding amounts. This financial report does not include donations in kind given by some Districts directly to the typhoon victims.

With prayerful discernment, the Executive Council of Servant Leaders (ECSL) allocated the total fund received based on the number of affected families and the number of damaged homes in the typhoon-affected areas covering Metro Manila, Northern and Southern Luzon. Kindly refer to Annex B for a summary of the allocation. The checks were personally turned over to the Bishops for the various victim-beneficiaries of their respective Dioceses.

We likewise gave financial assistance to BLD members directly affected by the typhoons; they were among the first beneficiaries.


May the Lord continue to bless our community as we go about serving Him in accordance to His teachings. Let us continue to pray for the typhoon victims, for the faithfulness of the Lord to be upon them in the long and arduous work of rebuilding their lives.
